


Parent Survey Feedback 2021- 2022

Thank you to all of the parents and carers that completed our annual survey this term. We had a good number of responses from across the school (250 in total):




Please find a summary of the feedback given below.

My child feels safe at this school:






98% agree or don't know <mark>2% disagree</mark>

My child is well looked after at this school:






99% agree or don't know <mark>1% disagree</mark>

School response:

It is always a really difficult task to get homework right for all families. In 2019-20 we consulted with parents at our school to ensure that what we are providing meets the expectations of the majority of parents whilst not putting families under too much pressure to complete work at home.

We now set the following homework for children:

- ✓ Daily reading (including reading challenges)
- ✓ Phonics and / or spellings tasks
- ✓ KIRFS (key instant recall facts) every half term
- √ 'Power Projects' every half term linked to wider curriculum learning

We also provide access to a number of education apps to support learning at home, including TT Rockstars, ReadingPlus and Espresso as well as devices to support children in accessing these out of school.

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved






97% agree or don't know <mark>3% disagree</mark>

School response:

Bullying is not acceptable in any form and we treat all cases of bullying extremely seriously. This involves speaking to and working with parents and carers, speaking with the children and putting in consequences and actions to prevent it from happening again.

We actually get very few cases of bullying at our school, though it does happen and can understandably cause a lot of upset. Please remember, not all unkind behaviour incidents are bullying. Bullying is if the same child or children are doing unkind things several times on purpose:

This does not mean that unkind actions by other children are in any way acceptable or will not be dealt with. It simply means that they are one-off incidents that will be addressed using our school's published behaviour policy.

We are not aware of any parents who are unhappy about any bullying incidents that may have occurred in the past.
