


Parent Survey Feedback

Thank you to all of the parents that completed our annual parent survey this term. We had a good number of responses from across the school (303 in total):



Please find a summary of the feedback given below.

For the lowest scoring answers, I have provided a response from school about how it is being addressed.

My child is happy at school

- 97% agree or don't know
- 3% disagree

My child feels safe at school

- 98% agree or don't know
- 2% disagree

My child makes good progress at school

- 95% agree or don't know
- 5% disagree

My child is well looked after at school

- 98% agree or don't know
- 2% disagree

My child is taught well at school

- 97% agree or don't know
- 3% disagree

My child received appropriate homework for their age

- 90% agree or don't know
- 10% disagree



We have just completed a separate homework survey with parents and, as expected, have received a range of views and opinions. We have also consulted with staff and the children.

We are currently updating our homework policy and will launch this in the new year.




The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved

- 14% disagree

- 6% disagree

- 12% disagree
